

DOVER HILL PARK

Dover Hill Park is one of St. Stephen's most photographed beauty spots. The view of the St. Croix river has been the backdrop for many wedding and graduation pictures— our floral displays and trails are maintained throughout the year. In the summer, take the trail down to the river's edge, where you can enjoy our urban oasis at the picnic tables and gazebo—and hit the toboggan hill in the winter!



ELM STREET PARK

Elm Street Park is a 60-acre wooded nature park located at the north end of Elm Street. The park is ideal for short hikes through the woods, dog walking, cross-country skiing, snowshoeing and biking. The trails are well marked and lead to Dennis Brook. There is no cost to use the nature park, and convenient parking is at the entrance.

DAVID A. GANONG CHOCOLATE PARK

KIWANIS SKATEPARK

GARCELON CIVIC CENTER (



The Garcelon Civic Center is the healthy living jewel in St. Stephen's crown! This modern, \$19 million facility is in the heart of downtown St. Stephen, and offers a full range of athletic, wellness, and cultural services to both residents and businesses. The facility includes the Quartermain Arena, which is an NHL-sized ice surface; the Sun Life walking track; a full conference centre for up to 250, a fitness centre, and an aquatic with both a 25-meter leisure pool and a therapy pool.

This is one of the few arenas that keeps the ice in year-round, so join us for skating all summer long!

Monuments, Memorials, AND emeteries




MILLTOWN COTTON MILL WORKERS MONUMENT

A proud part of the history of Milltown is the Cotton Mill and the key role it played in the economic development of our area. In 2007, The Milltown Cotton Mill Workers Monument was unveiled as a way to recognize the hard work and contributions of all the people who worked at the Mill during its 75 years of operation.

The Milltown War MILLTOWN WAR MEMORIAL

Memorial recognizes the names of the soldiers who paid the supreme sacrifice in World War I, World War II and the Korean Conflict. The Memorial is located in Memorial Park, on the corner of Queensway and Church Street.



ST. STEPHEN RURAL CEMETERY

The cemetery was incorporated in April 1856 and covers 65 acres of land with over 11500 burials. The cemetery is located in St. Stephen north of Hayman Avenue, just east of the junction of Highways 725 and 735.

MILLTOWN ROMAN CATHOLIC CEMETERY

This cemetery is the largest catholic cemetery in Charlotte County with over 2,530 known burials. Located in between the community of Milltown (Municipal District of St. Stephen) and Barter Settlement, on the northeastern side of the Barter Settlement Road (at civic number 32).

OAK BAY RURAL CEMETERY

There are over 1,185 known burials sites in the cemetery. The cemetery is located off Route 755 in the rural community of Oak Bay in the parish of St. David

WAR MEMORIAL CENOTAPH



The War Memorial Cenotaph is designated a Local Historic Place as being a solemn remembrance of the soldiers who paid the supreme sacrifice in World War I, World War II and the Korean Conflict.



ST STEPHEN NEW BRUNSWICK



St. Stephen was incorporated as a town in 1871. The addition of railroads to the area added another facet to St. Stephen's heritage by providing transportation to serve the burgeoning manufacturing sector. At one time the town was home to factories producing many goods, namely soap, shoes, baskets, axes, cigars, carriages, and of course chocolate. The architecture and some of the enterprises of this era can still be seen in St. Stephen. While times have changed, the perseverance of the people and diversification of its economic base have allowed the town to thrive.

St. Stephen's first settlers arrived many thousands of years ago while inland portions of North America were still locked in the last great Ice Age. Their descendants, the Passamaquoddy people, called the area Schoodic, which means, "fire place" or "where it burns". They valued it greatly as an important fishing place and tribal burial ground. After the end of the American Revolutionary War in 1783, Loyalists settled in St. Stephen and started to make it one of the Northeast's major lumbering and shipbuilding centers. Hundreds of ships took shape in local shipyards.





Canada's own

In 1873 brothers James and Gilbert Ganong opened a grocery store in St. Stephen. When it almost failed, they added candy—then considered a rare specialty item-to the list of wares for sale, and it started flying off the shelves. So, they started to make their own candy to sell in the store. From this modest beginning, Ganong Bros. Ltd. grew dramatically, and by 1930 the company was a major corporation employing 700 people. Ganong is still a major employer in our town.





In 1990, Ganong moved into its new factory. Their previous factory became the Chocolate Museum in 1999.



Located in the historic Ganong candy factory, the Chocolate Museum offers an interactive way to learn about candy making. Explore the history of the Ganong family and the wonder of chocolate with hands-on exhibits, vintage chocolate boxes, and antique candymaking equipment and machines.



You can even peek into the studio where Ganong's famous hand dippers still craft chocolates the way they have for more than one hundred years.

CHARLOTTE COUNTY MUSEUM



View art and life from the late 18th century onward. From the immigration of early settlers - the Loyalists, the Scots and the Irish - and illustrates their ties with the American Northeast. Open July and August.

TIME AND UNIVERSE



The Time and Universe sculpture was created by John Gogaberishvili in 2014. The red stone, which is separated from the main composition, designates new innovative time. There are three other stones located around the sculpture, one that depicts the sunrise, another that represents the night and the third one is still untouched.



WILLIAM FRANCIS GANONG STATUE



This bronze sculpture of William Francis Ganong was unveiled in St. Stephen in 2020. W. F. Ganong was a renowned scientist known for mapping New Brunswick's coastline, waterways, and mountains. There are maps engraved into the statue's back as a tribute to Ganong's love for his province.

ST. CROIX ART SHOWCASE

St. Croix Arts Showcase is an annual celebration that features visual art, art for sale, live entertainment, feature artist demonstrations, and art activities for all ages. This event usually takes place during the Chocolate Festival in early August.
